THE HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT MUST BE NOTIFIED 48 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF OPENING.

Approval, if given by the Town of Rehoboth and accepted by said applicant shall be upon these express conditions: That said applicant shall conform to the statutes and by-laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and "Town of Rehoboth" in effect and that may hereafter be in effect; that this permit may be revoked at any time by the Highway Superintendent; that between the hours of twilight and sunrise, the applicant will keep the road area safely marked by suitable signage of lighting. Any excavated area shall be completely filled or securely covered to allow for suitable vehicular or pedestrian traffic. During the workday period, the applicant shall have a suitable traffic control presence as determined by the Rehoboth Police Department; and that before any work is started under this application, the applicant shall, if requested by the Town of Rehoboth, provide a bond or insurance policy, in an amount and in such insurance company as determined by the Town with the Town named as a party insured against liability or indemnified for any or all damage or injury which may result to any property or party due to the work project or operation of the applicant, its agents or subcontractors.

Any temporary patching deemed necessary by the contractor shall be maintained in good repair at all times. The Town of Rehoboth reserves the right to make any temporary repairs it deems necessary to maintain the street in a safe and usable condition, and to charge the applicant for all costs involved in such repair. THE APPLICANT UNDER WHOSE PERMIT THE CONTRACTOR IS PERFORMING ANY WORK SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO KEEP SUCH EXCAVATION IN GOOD CONDITION.

COSTS: If any of the following are necessary, they will be paid for by the applicant.

- 1. Full time inspector
- 2. Warning devices
- 3. Traffic officers
- 4. Replacement of road surface as per regulations
- 5. Replacement of traffic lines

- 6. Replacement of loam and/or seed
- 7. Steel plates to cover trenches
- 8. Drainage pipes which may be broken (as per regulations)
- 9. Backfill of suitable material

REGULATIONS:

- 1. Disturbed drainage pipes will be replaced with ones long enough to extend 2' from each extremity.
- 2. No trench will be left overnight without approval
- 3. Only one-half of the road may be opened at one time
- 4. Contractors to use jack hammer or saw to ensure the least damage to the road
- 5. Backfill to be of material approved by the Highway Superintendent
- 6. Each layer shall be moistened and compacted by rolling and tamping to 90% compaction in layers not more that 6" deep
- 7. Patch to be Type I (2" binder and 1 ½" top) or the thickness of the road surface
- 8. Rehoboth Highway Department must be notified upon project completion
